To whom it may concern:

In response to your request for information to help you determine whether PALSUN, SUNTUF, SUNTOP and SUNLITE sheets would meet the requirements of the new limits for lead, heavy metals and certain phthalates in products intended for young children, as detailed in the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act ("CPSIA"; Pub. L. No. 110-314 (HR 4040); full text at <http://www.cpsc.gov/cpsia.pdf>), Palram can provide the following information:

The heavy metals (lead, antimony, arsenic, barium, mercury, cadmium, selenium, chromium) and the prohibited phthalates BBP, DBP, DEHP, DIDP, DINP and DnOP are not intentionally added to these products. Impurities, if present, would be expected only in trace amounts, below the threshold levels of 0.01% (long term threshold for lead in substrates) and 0.1% (immediate threshold for the phthalates), by weight.
